LESSON 1: CONVICTION AMID CONFLICT AND COMPROMISE

THE BOOK OF DANIEL DEALS PRIMARILY WITH THE SOVEREIGNTY AND PROVIDENCE OF GOD, YET IT ALSO HIGHLIGHTS THE CONVICTION AND FAITHFULNESS OF HIS SERVANTS — SEE 4:17.

EVEN IN THE FIRST CHAPTER OF DANIEL WE NOTE SEVERAL EXAMPLES OF THE ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT OF GOD IN THE WORLD:

- THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD IS MANIFESTED IN HIS PUNISHMENT OF THE WICKED — V. 2.
- THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD IS ALSO MANIFESTED IN HIS PROTECTION AND PROVISION FOR THE RIGHTEOUS VV. 9, 17.

WHEN WE RECOGNIZE THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD OVER ALL PEOPLE AND EVERY SITUATION, IT IS MUCH EASIER TO PERSONALLY AND FAITHFULLY COMMIT TO WORSHIPING AND SERVING HIM — 1:8.

- EVEN WHEN THERE IS CONFLICT, WE CAN MAINTAIN OUR RESOLVE – VV. 1-2.
- EVEN WHEN OTHERS COMPROMISE, WE CAN MAINTAIN OUR RESOLVE VV. 3-7.

FOR INSTANCE, THE BABYLONIANS TRIED TO BREAK THEIR CAPTIVES BY MODIFYING THEIR WORLDVIEW, THEIR VALUES, AND THEIR IDENTITY — 1:4, 7.

WAS CHANGED TO BELTESHAZZER ("BEL
[BABYLONIAN SUN GOD OF FERTILITY AND
STORMS, MARDUK?] PROTECT HIS LIFE") — SEE ISA
46:1.

FOR INSTANCE, THE BABYLONIANS TRIED TO BREAK THEIR CAPTIVES BY MODIFYING THEIR WORLDVIEW, THEIR VALUES, AND THEIR IDENTITY — 1:4, 7.

THE NAME OF HANANIAH ("YAH IS GRACIOUS")
 WAS CHANGED TO SHADRACH ("COMMAND OF
 AKU [BABYLONIAN MOOD GOD]") — SEE ISA
 46:1.

FOR INSTANCE, THE BABYLONIANS TRIED TO BREAK THEIR CAPTIVES BY MODIFYING THEIR WORLDVIEW, THEIR VALUES, AND THEIR IDENTITY — 1:4, 7.

• THE NAME OF MISHAEL ("WHO IS LIKE GOD?")
WAS CHANGED TO MESHACH ("WHO IS WHAT
AKU IS?") — SEE ISA 46:1.

FOR INSTANCE, THE BABYLONIANS TRIED TO BREAK THEIR CAPTIVES BY MODIFYING THEIR WORLDVIEW, THEIR VALUES, AND THEIR IDENTITY — 1:4, 7.

• THE NAME OF AZARIAH ("YAH HAS HELPED") WAS CHANGED TO ABED-NEGO ("SERVANT OF NEGO [PROBABLY NEBO, THE BABYLONIAN GOD OF WISDOM AND WRITING") — SEE JER 50:2.

IN SIMILAR FASHION, THE WORLD AROUND US IS TRYING TO CONFORM US TO ITS IMAGE; INSTEAD, WE MUST ALLOW GOD TO TRANSFORM US — ROM 12:2.

THIS REQUIRES, HOWEVER, THAT WE STRENGTHEN OUR RESOLVE, DETERMINING BEFOREHAND THAT WE WILL BE FAITHFUL TO THE LORD — DAN 1:8; ACTS 11:23.

• THIS MEANS THAT WE WILL NOT VIOLATE THE WILL OF GOD OR DAMAGE OUR REPUTATION AND INFLUENCE AS HIS SERVANT — SEE DEUT 14:3-21; 1 Cor 10:14-33.

THIS REQUIRES, HOWEVER, THAT WE STRENGTHEN OUR RESOLVE, DETERMINING BEFOREHAND THAT WE WILL BE FAITHFUL TO THE LORD — DAN 1:8; ACTS 11:23.

• THIS ALSO MEANS THAT WE WILL TRUST IN THE PROVIDENCE OF GOD AND LOOK FOR PEACEFUL YET UNCOMPROMISING WAYS TO LIVE IN THIS WORLD — SEE DAN 1:9-16.

IF WE RESOLVE TO CLING TO THE LORD, TRUSTING AND OBEYING HIM, HE WILL BLESS US; HE IS ABLE TO DO SO BECAUSE HE IS SOVEREIGN — DAN 1:17-21; SEE PS 63:8.
