LESSON 6: FAITH THAT BREAKS THE LAW

THE STORY OF DANIEL 6 FOCUSES LESS ON DANIEL AND HIS FAITHFULNESS TO GOD AND MORE ON HOW OTHERS AROUND DANIEL RESPONDED (POSITIVELY AND NEGATIVELY) TO HIS FAITH.

WHEN WE ALLOW GOD AND HIS WORD TO DETERMINE OUR COURSE OF CONDUCT, WE WILL BE DILIGENT AND DEPENDABLE, QUALITIES EVEN UNBELIEVERS TYPICALLY APPRECIATE – DAN 6:1-5.

 THE PHRASE "EXTRAORDINARY SPIRIT" PROBABLY RELATES NOT TO THE RELIGIOUS DEVOTION OF DANIEL BUT HIS WISDOM AND INTEGRITY IN SECULAR AND CIVIL MATTERS – VV. 3-5.

WHEN WE ALLOW GOD AND HIS WORD TO DETERMINE OUR COURSE OF CONDUCT, WE WILL BE DILIGENT AND DEPENDABLE, QUALITIES EVEN UNBELIEVERS TYPICALLY APPRECIATE – DAN 6:1-5.

 IT IS NOT SURPRISING THAT THE OTHER LEADERS, BEING UNSCRUPULOUS, WICKED MEN, BECAME JEALOUS OF DANIEL AND SOUGHT TO DESTROY HIS REPUTATION – V. 4.

WHEN WE ALLOW GOD AND HIS WORD TO DETERMINE OUR COURSE OF CONDUCT, WE WILL BE DILIGENT AND DEPENDABLE, QUALITIES EVEN UNBELIEVERS TYPICALLY APPRECIATE – DAN 6:1-5.

 DANIEL, HOWEVER, WAS A MAN OF IMPECCABLE CHARACTER AND ONLY BY DECEPTION COULD HIS ENEMIES ENTRAP HIM, KNOWING HE WOULD BE FAITHFUL TO GOD – VV. 4-5.

OUR FAITHFULNESS TO GOD WILL RESULT IN PERSECUTION, TYPICALLY ORGANIZED BY OUR PEERS, BUILT ON DECEPTION, AND TESTING OUR COMMITMENT – DAN 6:6-9.

IT IS DURING TIMES OF TEMPTATION/TRIAL THAT THE QUALITY OF OUR FAITH IS REVEALED, FORCING US TO CHOOSE FOR OR AGAINST GOD – DAN 6:10-15.

 DANIEL WAS AWARE OF THE LAW FORBIDDING PRAYER TO GOD AND THE CONSEQUENCE OF DISOBEDIENCE, BUT HE REFUSED TO DENY (OR HIDE) HIS ALLEGIANCE TO GOD – V. 10.

FAITH EVIDENCED BY PRAYER – V. 10.

IT IS DURING TIMES OF TEMPTATION/TRIAL THAT THE QUALITY OF OUR FAITH IS REVEALED, FORCING US TO CHOOSE FOR OR AGAINST GOD – DAN 6:10-15.

 DANIEL WAS AWARE OF THE LAW FORBIDDING PRAYER TO GOD AND THE CONSEQUENCE OF DISOBEDIENCE, BUT HE REFUSED TO DENY (OR HIDE) HIS ALLEGIANCE TO GOD – V. 10.

FAITH DEMANDS RESOLVE – ACTS 5:29.

IT IS DURING TIMES OF TEMPTATION/TRIAL THAT THE QUALITY OF OUR FAITH IS REVEALED, FORCING US TO CHOOSE FOR OR AGAINST GOD – DAN 6:10-15.

 THE ENEMIES OF DANIEL USED HIS FAITHFULNESS TO GOD AGAINST HIM, BUT DARIUS, WHO APPRECIATED THE INTEGRITY OF DANIEL, DESIRED ONLY GOOD FOR HIM – VV. 11-15.

WHILE THE CONSEQUENCES OF CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE TO SERVE GOD CAN BE DRASTIC, IT IS ALWAYS RIGHT FOR US TO OBEY HIM – DAN 6:16-18; SEE V. 14; REV 2:10.

WE WILL SUFFER FOR OBEYING GOD, BUT HE WILL DELIVER US, SAVING US FROM DEATH AND DESTROYING OUR ENEMIES, IF WE TRUST HIM – DAN 6:19-24; SEE 2 THESS 1:6-9.

 GOD IS FULLY ABLE TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE FROM SEEMINGLY HOPELESS SITUATIONS, AND HE DOES SO BECAUSE HE IS THE LIVING, ALL-POWERFUL, AND TRANSCENDENT GOD – DAN 6:20.

WE WILL SUFFER FOR OBEYING GOD, BUT HE WILL DELIVER US, SAVING US FROM DEATH AND DESTROYING OUR ENEMIES, IF WE TRUST HIM – DAN 6:19-24; SEE 2 THESS 1:6-9.

 BUT THE IMPORTANT LESSON WE LEARN FROM DANIEL IS THAT DELIVERANCE REQUIRES FAITH AND CONTINUED OBEDIENCE TO THE LORD AND BLAMELESS CHARACTER – DAN 6:20, 22-23.

IF WE PROVE FAITHFUL TO GOD WHEN THE PRICE OF OBEDIENCE IS HIGH, WE WILL BRING GREATER GLORY TO GOD AND INFLUENCE MORE PEOPLE FOR GOOD – DAN 6:25-28.

 THE FAITHFULNESS OF DANIEL (AGAIN) REVEALED THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD TO A PAGAN WORLD THAT REFUSED TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE LORD – VV. 25-27; SEE VV. 14, 16, 18-20, 23-24.

IF WE PROVE FAITHFUL TO GOD WHEN THE PRICE OF OBEDIENCE IS HIGH, WE WILL BRING GREATER GLORY TO GOD AND INFLUENCE MORE PEOPLE FOR GOOD – DAN 6:25-28.

 THOUGH GOD DOES NOT PROMISE THAT WE WILL ALWAYS PROSPER PHYSICALLY FOR OUR FAITH, DANIEL WAS BLESSED EACH TIME HE FACED DIFFICULTY AND REMAINED TRUE TO GOD.

IF WE WILL, LIKE DANIEL, LIVE A LIFE CHARACTERIZED BY RIGHTEOUSNESS, FAITH, AND PRAYER, WE WILL BE PERSECUTED, BUT WE WILL ALSO ULTIMATELY BE DELIVERED AND BLESSED BY THE LORD, BRING GLORY TO HIS NAME.
