# What Is Death?

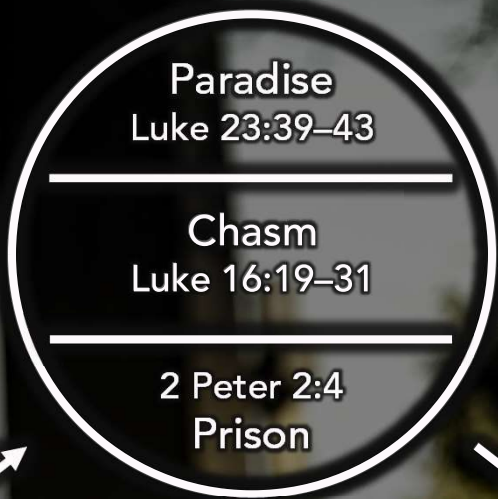
- Death is natural and unnatural – Genesis 1:31; Romans 5:12; 1 Corinthians 15:21–22.
